

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LOREBURN NO. 254
BYLAW NO. 02-2017

**A BYLAW RESPECTING FIREWORKS IN THE RESORT RESIDENTIAL
ZONE IN THE MUNICIPALITY**

The council of the Rural Municipality of Loreburn No. 254 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

DEFINITIONS

1. In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires, the expression:
 - (a) "fireworks" means firecrackers, rocket, squib, or any other object or substance designed to be exploded or burned to produce noises or brilliant lighting effects does not include paper percussion caps for toy guns.
 - (b) "fireworks display" shall mean a display of fireworks for the entertainment of the public at large.

PROHIBITION

2. No person shall set off, detonate, ignite or cause to be exploded any fireworks in the Resort Residential Zone of the Rural Municipality of Loreburn No. 254

PENALTY

3. Any person found guilty of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to a penalty as per Bylaw No, 13/2005 known as the Penalty Bylaw.
