The Reeve can sign the Road Maintenance Agreement No 02/2017 with Enbridge.

We accept Enbridge's process for the application of dust control with it being ran through the RM of Loreburn.

That effective immediately we issue an open fire burn ban for the Resort Residential Are within the RM of Loreburn, known as the Lakeside RV Trailer Park. Contravention of this ban will result in fines, in accordance with the General Penalty Bylaw 13/2005 and if the fire department is called to attend a fire as a result of burning during the ban, the fire response fees will be billed directly to the owner of the property. The open fire ban can be removed or reapplied by approval from the Reeve.

We apply to the Ministry of Highways & Infrastructure for an additional 2,000 cubic meters of Reject Sand from the Ministry pit on the land location SW 29-27-07 W3.
