We send our seasonal employees to Ground Disturbance Training in 2018.

The nuisance grounds will be closed on Dec. 26, 2017 in lieu of Boxing Day Holiday.

Ron Savidan can attend the PREP PCO workshop in Saskatoon on January 18, 2018 with expenses paid for attending.

We are going to go with our engineer, AMEC's recommendation for the internal roads at SunSet Beach Resort. Council will allow communications between AMEC and AE but the RM must be included in all correspondence and if there are any meetings the RM office must be emailed the minutes/discussion points within 3 days of the meeting.

We hire Hole Shot Services to help with stockpiling of gravel.

We enter into an agreement with Department of Highways Central Region for ditch mowing of approximately 72.6 ha for the 2018 season.

We purchase a 2018 140M CAT Grader. The 2012 140M CAT grader being traded in. Payment will be made upon delivery in spring of 2018.

We set the January 2018 meeting for Thursday January 11, 2018 at 1:00 p.m.

Both the Elbow and Loreburn Library boards will each receive the capital grant of \$1000 each.

The RM will pay the Village of Loreburn for our fire agreement.

The Administrator can pay any invoices that are needed for 2017 year end at the end of December 2017.

1/3 of the moneys paid to the Reeve and councilors be allotted as expenses under the Income Tax Act.

All loan arrears as presented by the Line 19 Water Utility will be applied to and become part of the municipal taxes of each subscriber in arrears.

On December 31, 2017 all outstanding custom work will be applied to and become part of the municipal taxes of each landowner for whom the work was done.

All outstanding custom mowing for Lakeside RV Park be applied to and become part of the municipal taxes of each landowner for whom the work was done.

We agree to fund the Elbow Library for 33% of the extra 4 hours of opening for 2018, our share being \$1,363.97; and the Loreburn Library for the requested extra 2.0 hours, our share being \$2,088.00.

We will renew our Paymate program for 2018 and pay the costs.

The SK Worker's Board Industry Premium Rate for 2018 was accepted.

We purchase a Highline RCHIII15-401 RCH Hydro Mower from John Bob Farm Equipment. We will trade in our 2014 Schulte XH 1500 Rotary Mower with Handi Hitch.

The RM will share the expenses for First Responder Verna Urlacher to attend the EMS Conference in Moose Jaw in January.

We abate a portion of the municipal tax for PT NE 20-27-05 W3 for half of the year. The school portion of the tax must be paid in full.

We pay the RCMP levy for the 2017 year.
