January 11, Meeting

Doug Taylor will register for the MLDP module that is being held on Monday, March 13, 2018 with expenses paid for by the RM.

The RM will submit a resolution to SARM for the 2018 March Convention requesting SARM to lobby SaskPower to put the single phase power lines underground instead of replacing the old power poles with new power poles. The main reason for the resolution is due to safety concerns with power poles being hit by agricultural equipment. Procedures will be followed for submitting a resolution to SARM by January 26, 2018.

The Administrators' membership fees in RMAA be paid for 2018.

The nuisance grounds hours will be changed to Tuesday from 1-5 pm from January 16—March 31, 2018 due to the recent retirement of one of our employees. This resolution will be attached to Bylaw 09-2016.

The holidays for Steven South and Vanessa Tastad were approved.

The administrator can attend the SAMA training session for administrator's on April 10, 2018 in Saskatoon with expenses paid for by the RM.

We give approval for the proposed gas pipeline to serve the Lakeside RV Park & Development for Block 5 and the Reeve has approval to sign the right of way and easement agreement for Blk/Par MR4 & W1 Plan No. 102086771.

That we enter into an agreement with Prairie's Edge Development Corporation for a tax exemption for the purpose of economic development for the subdivision for Phase 1 that has been proposed to council.

We will join Agricultural Producers Association of Saskatchewan (APAS) by paying for the transitional membership for 2018

The RM will allocate our portion for the SK Lotteries Grant for 2018 between the 4 Villages in our Boundaries and the Reeve can sign the application forms.

Membership in the Hudson Bay Route Association for 2018 was renewed for \$300.

The 2018 Palliser Regional Library Levies totaling \$4800.75 be paid.

The 2018 RCMP Rural policing Levy of \$14549.21 will be paid.

The RM will purchase excess liability insurance of \$2 million for the 2018 year.

The 2018 SARM Property Self-Insurance Program will be paid.

The RM will purchase the SARM Fidelity Bond for 2018 and pay the annual premium.

The RM will renew our SARM Liability Self-Insurance for 2018 and pay the premium.

The SARM Short Term Disability benefits premium will be paid and half of these premiums will be charged back to the employees by deducting it off each pay cheque.

The SARM Extended Health and Dental Benefits for the employees will be paid with employees paying half of the premium by deducting it off each pay cheque.

The employees will enroll in the SARM Long Term Disability and pay the premium with the employees paying back the total cost by deducting it off each pay cheque.

We will renew our membership in SARM for 2018 at a rate of \$3604.26.

We will renew our Munisoft Equipment and Software support for 2018.

We pay the 911 dispatch services fee to The City of Prince Albert for 2018.

The RM will pay our 2017 recipient for the LCS Scholarship as he has completed his post-secondary education.

We agree to maintain the roadways within the Gardiner Dam Maintenance area with Water Security for the period of April 1, 2018 through to March 31, 2019 and charge our non—ratepayer's custom rates for 2018.

We renew our agreement with GDT Joint Venture so our ratepayers have access to the tank loader that is situated on NE 11-27-05 W3.

Council gave a 3rd and final reading of Bylaw No. 01-2018 Being a Bylaw to Provide for Entering into an Agreement with the Village of Elbow Respecting the Provision of Fire Protection Services and was adopted.
