January 11, Meeting

Doug Taylor and Vanessa Tastad will register for the MLDP modules that are being held on Monday, March 13, 2017 with expenses paid for by the RM.

The Administrators' membership fees in RMAA be paid for 2017.

Part time Assistant's wage was reviewed and approved.

The invoice #225250 for \$4200 for maintenance of the Municipal Reserve Land located at NE 2-25-05 W3 and Municipal Reserve Maintenance Contract 01- 2017 with Lakeside RV Park Ltd. was paid and accepted.

The RM will pay \$20,000 to the Village of Hawarden to help with their upgrades to the water plant, and requests that this service stays open for rural use.

The Reeve and Administrator have permission to sign the Management Responsibility Declaration and Engagement Letter for the 2016 financial statements.

The RM will allocate our portion for the SK Lotteries Grant for 2018 between the 4 Villages in our Boundaries and the Reeve can sign the application forms.

The Reeve will sign the Application to Purchase Agricultural Lease Land for NE 32-27-07-W3 as we agree to the sale of this land.

Membership in the Hudson Bay Route Association for 2017 was renewed for \$300.

The 2017 Palliser Regional Library Levies totaling \$4800.75 be paid.

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The 2016 RCMP Rural policing Levy of \$14938.49 will be paid.

The RM will purchase excess liability insurance of \$2 million for the 2017 year.

The SARM Property Self-Insurance Program will be paid in the amount of \$7017.75

The RM will purchase the SARM Fidelity Bond for 2017 and pay the annual premium of \$100.

The RM will renew our SARM Liability Self-Insurance for 2017 and pay the \$1995.72 premium.

The SARM Short Term Disability benefits premium of \$6779.42 will be paid and half of these premiums will be charged back to the employees by deducting it off each pay cheque.

The SARM Extended Health and Dental Benefits for the employees for \$17574.83 will be paid with employees paying half of the premium by deducting it off each pay cheque.

The employees will enroll in the SARM Long Term Disability and pay the premium of \$4314.27, with the employees paying back the total cost by deducting it off each pay cheque.

We will renew our membership in SARM for 2017 at a rate of \$3509.98.

We will renew our Munisoft Equipment and Software support for 2017 in the amount of \$5566.

The City of Prince Albert will receive \$432.50 for our 2017 911 dispatch services.

The RM will pay our 2016 recipient for the LCS Scholarship as he has completed his first term of post-secondary education and is continuing on with his education.

The proposed subdivision application for Property Line Realignment Lots 27, 28, 29, Block 1 and Walkway W3, does not meet council approval. Council does support keeping the existing walkway where it is and removing the proposed W3 walkway and rearranging the internal boundaries of the 3 lots if needed.

We agree to maintain the roadways within the GDT Maintenance area for the period of April 1, 2017 through to March 31, 2018 and charge our non-ratepayer's custom rates for 2017.

We will pay the school tax portion of 52% for the mobile dwelling fees for 2016 for the total of \$2184.

Council gave a 3rd and final reading of Bylaw No. 01-2017 Being a Bylaw for the Resort Residential Zone of the RM of Loreburn No. 254 to Regulate the Speed of motor Vehicles.
