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## July Meeting Minutes

A school bus sign will be installed on the Townline Road at the Snustead Farms Inc. residence on the NW 36-27-04 W3.

The RM donated \$5000.00 to Iver Main Place for the upcoming upgrades/expansion.

Nona Stronski and Vanessa Tastad are approved to job share the Administration position at 3/5's time starting January 1, 2014.

The Gardiner Dam Terminal access road becomes part of the regular grading schedule by the graders.

That we bill AAFC for custom spraying in the Rudy/Rosedale Community Pasture at a rate of \$150.00/hr plus \$50.00 for chemical used.

We will contact the individuals in the Phase 1 of the Lakeside Trailer RV Park Ltd to see if they would like tree sap put on Lakeside Road to help with dust. This application would be at the cost of the ratepayer and we ask that McGill's incorporate this in at the time of application for the Douglas Provincial Park for 2014.

Two yield signs are to be installed at the intersection of the BonnieView Road and the NW 07/26/06 W3 for traffic going north and south.

The Zoning Bylaw #02/2013 be amended as per WaterWOolf's suggestion for Accessory Residential buildings in the Resort residential Zone of the RM of Loreburn.

Administration is to provide a written response to the Minister of Government Relations regarding the review of property tax tools with the suggestion of having more subclasses.

The List of Arrears was presented to the Reeve. All tax arrears equal to or less than ½ of the previous year's levy shall be deleted from the List. All landowners will be given 30 days to make payment before the List will be advertised in the paper.

All expenses for the RM's supper barbeque will be paid.

Each Division approve the following gravel allocation for 2013: Division 1,2,4 & 5 – 2,500 cu. yds., Division 3 – 1500 cu yds; and Division 6 – 21 cu. Yds.

The Reeve is authorized to sign the agreement with X-Calibur for the integrity dig on the Township Road 262, within SE 15-26-05 W3 with completion date to be July 31, 2013.

A bylaw to regulate the speed of motor vehicles for the Resort Residential Zone of the RM be given three readings and passed.

## August Meeting Minutes

That when letters are sent to the property owners (vacant lots included) in Phase 1 of the Lakeside Trailer RV Park Ltd they be informed that the costs for applying tree sap to the road to help with dust control will be approximately \$100.00 per lot.

We donate \$2,500 to the Stars Helicopter Air Ambulance program.

We charge DF Welding for 60 yards of gravel at \$4.19 per cubic yard plus \$1.10 for loading and \$.30 per cubic yard mile (\$767.40) for the road cut on the Bonnie View Grid.

That we enter into a road haul agreement with Bob's Backhoe Service for the road haul for the MR1 canal project.

That we do not sell gravel to the RM of Maple Bush for the road leading to the Coyote Springs Campground.

## September Meeting Minutes

A motion was made to advertise for the Office Assistant position in The Outlook and The Davidson Leader with a closing date of October 4, 2013.

Nona Stronski and Vanessa Tastad may attend the RMAA District Meeting in Hague on Sept 18/13.

All employees will be enrolled in the SARM short term disability, and extended health & dental benefit programs for 2014 with employees paying half the premiums.

Council approved an overhead primary powerline in the road allowance to provide service to NE 15-26-06 W3 and have no plans at the future to expand the road allowance.

The RCMP levy of \$13,096.10 be paid for the 2013 year.

A resolution was passed stating that the RM of Loreburn #254 is opposed to any reduction of services proposed by the Canadian Post Corporation for Hawarden Post Office.

That Bylaw 14/2013 being a Bylaw to Amend the Waterwolf Planning District was giving three readings and adopted.
