## July Meeting Minutes

Nona Stronski was appointed to act as Returning Officer for the 2012 election if necessary. All election officials will be paid \$150.00 for their duties and all divisions will hold the vote in the RM Office in Loreburn.

Garry Stone reported on the municipal sector consultation meeting on the operating plan for Lake Diefenbaker. The recommendation coming from that meeting was to maintain the levels of the lake at one meter from full.

The List of Land in Arrears was presented to the Reeve. Anyone with ½ of the previous year's levy owing was deleted from the List.

A letter was sent to MLA Gerry Ritz and Lyle Stewart opposing the dissolution of the PFRA community pasture program.

\$500.00 will be donated to the Village of Elbow's July 1<sup>st</sup> fireworks display.

Council approved the naming of the road running south on Highway 44 from the SW 30-26-05 W3 the Wild Lily Road.

Bylaw No. 04/2012 being a bylaw to extend the hours for voting was given final reading.

## August Meeting Minutes

Council approved the Development Permit 04/2012 as submitted by Larry Peterman for the proposed campground on the SE 04-27-06 W3.

Council approved the Development Permit as submitted by Cory Kobelsky on Part of the NW 12-25-05 W3 "conditional" to receiving confirmation from the developer that he has water and sewer agreements in place.

Council approved the amended development/building permit application from Milton Loitz for a shop.

A new water meter coin dispenser for the municipal tank loaders will be purchased so it will accept new loonies and toonies.

## September Meeting Minutes

The RM will not be doing any custom work/road construction outside the municipality for an indefinite period of time as we have more of our own work than we can manage at present.

The RM has rented a 627 Cat Scraper from Kramer Ltd. for one month to assist with construction.

We pay the 2012 RCMP policing invoice for \$11,902.40.

All employees will be enrolled in the SARM short term disability program for 2013 with employees paying half the premiums

Council approved the open cut/excavation request by Excalibur Pipeline and Utility locations for the Enbridge investigate digs on the NE 10-26-05 W3 and NE 01-26-05 W3.

Council donated \$1000.00 to the Elbow and District Museum and Historical Society to assist in the costs of replacing the shingles on the roof of the museum.

The RM will be purchasing a John Deere 444K 2011 Loader from Brandt Ltd.

The development permit for Cory Kobelski was not approved as he has no long term lagoon agreement.

The development permit submitted by Larry and Leanne Rinholm cannot be approved until SE approves his sewage disposal system proposal.

The development permit submitted by Norm and Marian Campbell is approved.

The proposed residential subdivision application for SW 21-25-04 W3 be approved as it complies with our Zoning Bylaw 02-98 Section 5.3.2.

The RM is sending a letter to Minister of Highways stating their concern with their mowing policy for highways in our area.
