Council authorizes the administrator to proceed with tax enforcement on specific parcels.

Tenders will be received for one load of culverts from Prairie Steel, Armtec and Canada Culverts. Tenders must be received by June 9 at 4.00 p.m

We will contract the Travel Club to go and pick up garbage at the RM Landfill Site and will be paid for this service.

That we purchase 2 FM radios with the RM frequency for the Loreburn Fire Department to be installed in the Loreburn fire trucks.

That the renewal fee for the Industrial Vegetation Application License for Steven South, Matthew Hauberg and Dwayne Stamnes be paid.

The Administrator is directed to draw up the draft bylaw to rezone the NW 12-25-05 W3 Ext. 61 to commercial as per the ratepayers request.

The budget is approved with a mill rate of 6.25 mills with a mill rate factor of 0.06 on agriculture, 1.00 on residential and 1.30 on commercial.

The RM's LCS Scholarship for 2017 be awarded to Geraiame Brochu.

That we institute a 60 km/hr speed limit for 8 tonne vehicles for the Clearing the Path Route in the RM of Loreburn upon passing of such a bylaw.
