## December 2, Meeting

Employees salaries were reviewed and approved.

That Nona Stronski will be paid a daily rate of \$150.00 per day when working in the office.

Darryl Norrish will be hired at \$30.00 per hour for project work by the RM.

That we pay Matt Hauberg \$30/mo for the use of his personal cell phone for municipal business.

Ron Savidan will be given permission to attend the PREP PCO workshop in Saskatoon on January 26, 2016. Ron will use one of the RM trucks for transportation and the RM will pay his other expenses.

That our January meeting will be held on January 6, 2016 at 1.00 pm in the RM Office in Loreburn.

Changes were made to the 2016 SARM Property Insurance program to increase the Fire Fighting expense to the maximum coverage of \$20,000.

The Villages were paid their recreation grants for 2015.

The Elbow and Loreburn Library boards were paid the yearly capital grant.

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All Villages were paid the Fire agreement grants.

All loan arrears incurred by the CRPU and Line 19 Water Utility will be added to the municipal taxes. On December 31, 2015 all outstanding custom work will be applied to and become part of the municipal taxes of each landowner for whom the work was done.

We agree to fund the Elbow Library for 33% of the extra 3.75 hours of opening for 2016, our share being \$1,142.21; and the Loreburn Library for the requested extra 1.75 hours, our share being \$1,818.25.

Garry Book and Kevin Vollmer be approved to review the Ag Crown Land for Sale Applications on behalf of the RM.

We approve the Ag Crown Land application for the SE 17-25-05, SW 17-25-05 and W 1/2 NW 17-25-05 W3.

That the Reeve sign the Blanket Temporary Access Consent Request from X-Calibur on behalf of Enbridge for pipeline integrity digs for 2016.

That the Road Committee be formed consisting of Kevin Vollmer, Rod Vollmer, and Garry Book and that we opt out of the order by the Ministry of Highways for Winter Weight Season Road Restrictions.

That we close the nuisance grounds on Saturdays effective January 1, 2016 until March 31, 2016 and that the nuisance grounds will be closed on December 26, 2015 (Boxing Day).

The proposed sub division for NE 02-25-05 W3 for proposed Parcel X and Parcel Y, that is currently zoned Agriculture/resource district complies with our Zoning Bylaw 02-2013 under Section 7.1.2(2), stating that residence or farmstead on a site of less than a quarter section and Section 4.3.1 stating that the dwelling maybe in the form of a mobile home or modular home. No service agreement or municipal reserve is required by the RM at this time. If the intended use of the land is to change then the applicant will need to follow the necessary procedures that are required.

We enter into a Road Haul Agreement with Enbridge Pipelines.

That we notify Larry Peterman in regards to the process to get development approval.

Council gave 3rd and final reading for Bylaw 04/2015 being a Bylaw to Provide for Entering into an Agreement with the Village of Elbow respecting Fire Protection Services.
