

A BYLAW CONCERNING THE ERECTION OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SIGNS

The council of the Rural Municipality of Loreburn No. 254, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw the expression "road" means any public highway within the municipality as defined in The Highways Act, other than a Provincial Highway as designated pursuant to such Act.

2. "Stop" signs shall be erected at the intersection of roadways at the following locations:

<u>LOCATION OF INTERSECTION</u>	<u>SIDE OF ROAD</u>	<u>DIRECTION FROM INTERSECTION</u>	<u>FACING TRAFFIC FROM</u>
1. NW 23-23-5 W3	East	South	South

3. "Yield" signs shall be erected at the intersection of roadways at the following locations:

<u>LOCATION OF INTERSECTION</u>	<u>SIDE OF ROAD</u>	<u>DIRECTION FROM INTERSECTION</u>	<u>FACING TRAFFIC FROM</u>
1. SE 27-26-5	West	North	North
2. SE 27-26-6	West	North	North
3. NW 21-27-5	East	South	South
4. SE 25-27-6	West	North	North
5. SW 30-27-6	North	East	East
6. NE 24-27-7	South	West	West
7. NW 21-23-5	East	South	South
8. SE 28-23-5	West	North	North
9. NW 11-23-5	East	South	South
10. NW 23-27-5	East	South	South
11. SE 27-27-5	West	North	North
12. SE 28-27-7	West	North	North
13. NE of SE 12-27-7	South	West	West
14. NW 6-27-6	South	West	West

4. All signs erected pursuant to Section 2 and 3 hereof shall be erected not less than two metres and not more than fifteen metres preferably four metres from the near edge of the intersected roadway.

5. The provisions of The Vehicles Act shall apply, wherever applicable to every sign erected pursuant to Section 2 and 3.

6. No person shall alter, damage, remove, deface, knock down or tamper with any sign erected pursuant to this Bylaw.

7. Any person who violates any provision of this Bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.

8. Bylaw 2/69 passed by council on November 12, 1969 is hereby repealed.
