BYLAW NO 05/2013

A BYLAW TO APPOINT A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Loreburn No. 254 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) “Council” means the Council of the Rural Municipality of Loreburn No. 254; and
 - b) “Municipality” means the Rural Municipality of Loreburn.
2. Council hereby appoints Ron Savidan as the Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Municipality.
3. The appointment shall commence May 1, 2013 and shall continue at the pleasure of council.
4. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer giving 60 days written notice.
5. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be
 - a) to enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the council of the Municipality
 - b) to represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw;
 - c) and other duties as may be assigned by council or its delegate

6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on Apr 23, 2013.
