

## July 13, 2015 Meeting

Employee summer holidays have been approved.

Gale Hagblom, the contract planner, will come out one day in July, August with expenses paid to work with the administrator on zoning amendments.

The council appointed Vanessa Tastad to act as Returning Officer, Nona Stronski as Deputy Returning Officer and Janell Hundebly as Poll Clerk for the municipal election in 2016. The election officials will be paid \$150/day for their duties and all polls will be in the R.M. Office in Loreburn.

The proposed plan for joining the ratepayers laneways for Lot 19B Block 1 be approved with no clean out option. The RM will do the work because it is in our right of way and the ratepayer will pay for all costs associated with the work.

The Administrator presented the List of land in arrears to the Reeve.

Tax Arrears that are equal to or less than 1/2 of the previous year's levy shall be deleted from the List of Land in Arrears. We will notify land owners whose land is on the List of Land in Arrears that 30 days from date of mailing the land in arrears will be advertised in the paper unless the arrears are paid in full before that date.

Permission was given for 2 primary super B loads to be hauled on Hundebay Road, then north on the 4 Mile Road to the Heavy Haul Road. There will be a restriction of 60 km/hr speed for these loads for the whole route.
