June Minutes

The municipality is entering into an agreement with the Village of Loreburn for the use of the “red” Loraas bin for RM Ratepayers to use and will notify the ratepayers when the tax notices are sent out.

The Office will be closed Friday afternoons starting July 1—September 30.

Reeve Kevin Vollmer signed the Clearing the Path Agreement with SARM.

The Municipality is going to implement a scholarship at the Loreburn Central School, into perpetuity, in which council will select a recipient who is going onto secondary education and also based on community and school leadership.

Tom & Rick Jukes will act as mower operators for the Phase I Jukes development. Any custom work outstanding at the end of the year will be applied to the taxes of the parcel receiving the service.

The Reeve was directed to sign the funding agreement with Multi-Material Stewardship Western Inc.

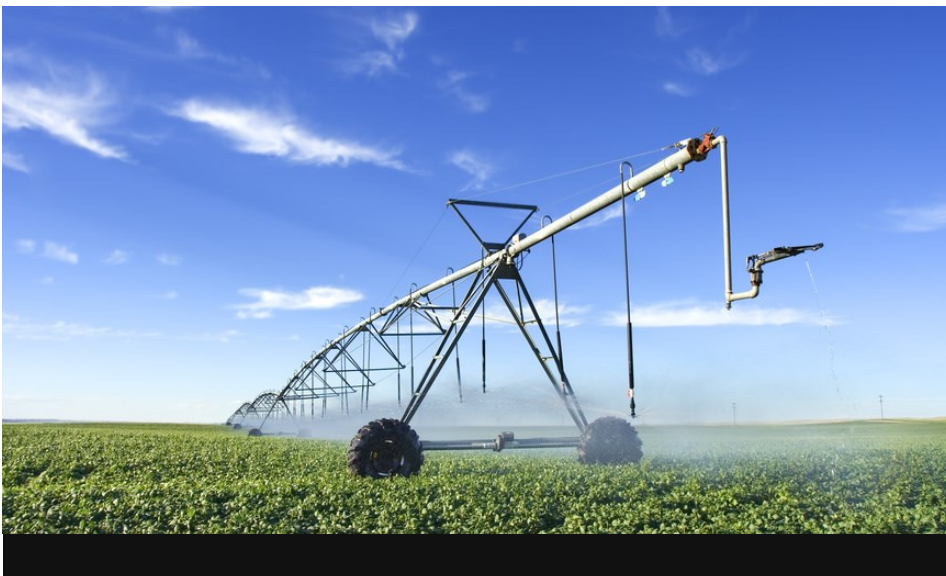
The subdivision on the W 1/2 13-25-05 W3 was given approval.

Approval was given to the subdivision application on the S 1/2 05/25/04 W3 and part of NE 32-24-04 W3 as it is compliant with our Zoning Bylaw.

Ron Savidan attended the Pest Control Convention on June 11 & 12 in Moose Jaw.

Membership in the South SK River Watershed Stewards is renewed.

WaterWolf Development Appeals board is appointed to act for the municipality.

Screens will be purchased for the pump at the dugout at GDT.

The tender for the Terex TS14B from Lorne Lowdermilk was accepted.

That we purchase culverts from Canada Culvert as they have the earliest delivery date.

That in conjunction with RM'2 251, 252, and 253 we request the East-West Heavy Haul Road (CTP primary weight corridor) in our RM be reclassified as a Class 4 Road throughout its length within these municipalities under the Ministry of Highways classification system and further a request be made that this road be given Primary Grid Road number (i.e. #748) continuous through the length of this roadway between Highway #2 to the East and to the Junction of Highway #44 West and #219.
