That we approve the budget for 2016 and set the mill rate of 6.8 mills with a mill rate factor of 1 on agricultural and residential and a mill rate factor of 1.06 on commercial

We approve Sask Water's installation of the non-potable pipelines crossing the municipal right of ways in the SE 10-25-05 W3 and the NE 10-25-05 W3.

Council authorizes the Administrator to proceed with tax enforcement and to start proceedings for title on the designated properties.

The RM will install two signs along the Clearing The Path route designating the 4 mile road going south as the "Vollmer Road" and all costs are the responsibility of the ratepayer, David Vollmer.
