The following officers are declared elected—Brian Brown, Division 2, Rod Vollmer, Division 4 and Garry Stone Division 6.

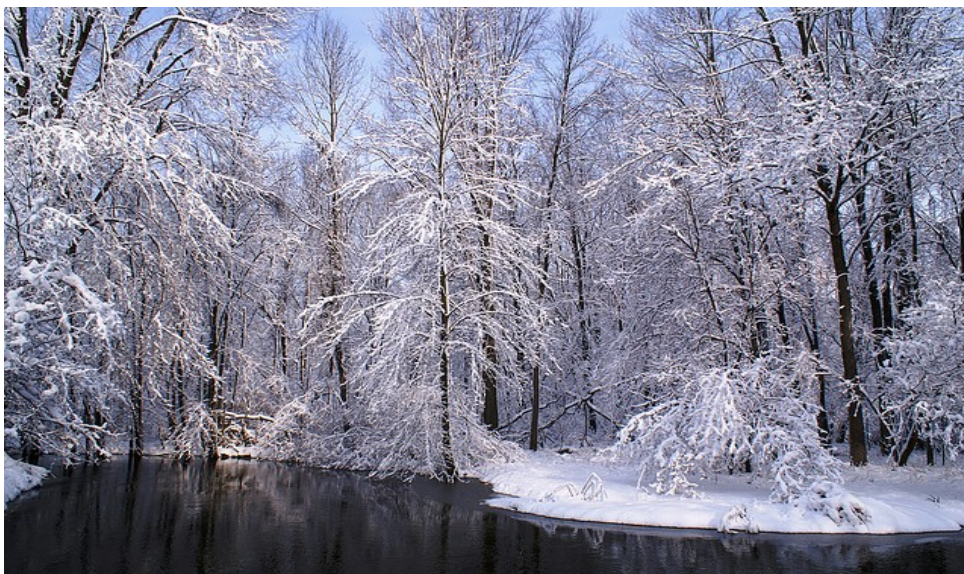

That if changes are made to the NW 28-26-06 W3 subdivision application as proposed by Community Planning, we will not support accepting the proposal dedicating the 30m wide access strip along the south of the quarter as a service road designating it to the RM.
